Your initial consultation with a cardiologist will involve a thorough review of your medical history and an assessment of coronary artery disease risk factors. Expect measurements of your heart rate and blood pressure, possibly including an electrocardiogram (ECG). The cardiologist will conduct a comprehensive cardiac and vascular physical examination.
