An endocrinologist is a medical doctor specializing in diagnosing and treating hormonal imbalances. These imbalances can involve either overproduction (hypersecretion) or underproduction (hyposecretion) of hormones by endocrine glands.

7. What symptoms warrant a consultation with an endocrinologist?

Endocrinologist consultation is recommended for symptoms such as amenorrhea, sudden weight changes (gain or loss), polyuria, neck swelling, dizziness, insomnia, infertility, menstrual irregularities, alopecia, hirsutism, and melasma.

8. What diseases does an endocrinologist treat?

Endocrinologists specialize in diagnosing and treating hormonal disorders. These include diabetes mellitus, hyperthyroidism, hypothyroidism, polycystic ovarian disease (PCOD), infertility, growth hormone disorders (dwarfism, gigantism), hyperparathyroidism, hypoparathyroidism, metabolic disorders, pituitary disorders (hypopituitarism, hyperpituitarism), and certain hormone-related cancers. They manage conditions stemming from imbalances in the body's endocrine system.

9. What training is required to become an endocrinologist?

Endocrinologists require a three-year DM Endocrinology degree following postgraduate training in general or internal medicine and successful completion of a super-specialty entrance exam. Only MBBS graduates are eligible for endocrinology specialization.

10. Can an endocrinologist treat PCOD?

Yes, an endocrinologist treats Polycystic Ovary Disease (PCOD) using hormonal therapy. Diagnosis involves testing follicle-stimulating hormone (FSH), luteinizing hormone (LH) levels, and abdominal ultrasonography.
