10. What are the educational requirements to become a General Physician?

General physicians, also known as primary care physicians, require completion of a medical residency in primary care following graduation from medical school. Prerequisites include a science-based bachelor's degree, a minimum GPA, successful completion of medical school, and foundational medical training. A three-year residency commitment is mandatory.
